OUR SPACES

Opening Times:

The Union is open Monday to Friday from 8am-11pm.

- Bookings for the bars and Bistro are open from 5pm
- Bookings for the committee rooms are open from 6pm

We may be able to offer earlier booking for the bars, subject to availability and staffing. If this is required please indicate this on your room booking form.

Affiliation with the union allows your priority to book any of our wonderful spaces below!

The Venue:

Capacity:

- Standing - 900 (including 120 balcony seats)
- Seated - 300

Our venue is a historic live music space. It comes equipped with a full lighting rig and sound design. This is an ideal space for shows, club nights and ceilidhs. The venue can also be set up in a 'big bar' style to accommodate larger socials.

Jim's Bar:

Capacity:

- Standing - 150
- Seated - 80

Jim's Bar is a more intimate live music space which features the original stage on which Queen performed. This is our 'mini venue' which is great for smaller scale shows and club nights. This is an ideal space for pub quizzes and karaoke nights.

The Games Bar:

Capacity:

- Standing - 150
- Seated - 80

With pool, darts and TVs, the Games Bar is ready to host any social you can imagine. The Games Bar has hosted BSL masterclasses, karaoke socials, post-game boozing sessions, Therapets, and more.

Cafe and Hot Food Offering:

Capacity:

- Seated - 30

Our laid-back cafe on the ground floor can be booked for more relaxed social events or movie screenings.

Bistro:

Capacity:

- Seated - 80
- Standing - 150

Our lantern-lit Bistro space on the second floor is perfect for dinners, banquets, and many other activities like quizzes or larger meetings.

Committee Rooms & Reflection Room:

Capacity:

- 20-36 [varies by room]

All of our committee rooms come equipped with a computer monitor and projector. These are your ideal spaces for meetings and AGMs. They can also be used for smaller socials such as movie screenings. Drinks purchased from the bar can be brought up to the committee rooms.

Foyer and outside area:

In addition to our wide selection of rooms, all our affiliated clubs and societies can book the foyer and outside area for fundraising stalls subject to approval.

BOOKING FEES:

Committee Rooms and The Foyer are free to book for any affiliated club or society.

Jim's Bar and the Games Bar are subject to a £300 booking fee. Fees are completely redeemable provided over £500 has been spent behind the bar.

The venue is subject to a £500 booking fee.

A fee may apply to Bistro booking upon enquiry.
