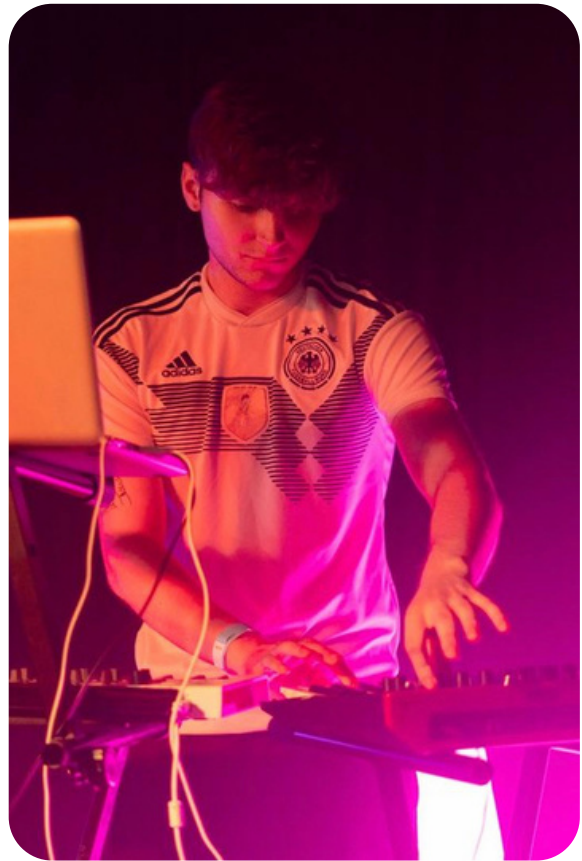


GREGOR KELMAN
