OUR SPACES

Opening times

The union is open Monday to Friday. Bookings for the Bars and Bistro open at 5pm, the Committee rooms may only be booked from 6pm onwards.

- **Monday and Tuesday: Rooms may be booked from 6pm – 10 pm**
- **Wednesday to Friday: Rooms may be booked from 6pm – 11pm**

Subject to availability and staffing we may offer earlier booking for the Bars, if this is required please indicate this on your room booking form.

Affiliation to the union allows you to book any of the [great] spaces below!

The Venue

Capacity:

- Standing - 900 (including balcony)
- Seated - 300

Our Venue is a historic live music space, it comes equipped with a full lighting rig and sound design. This is an ideal space for shows, club nights and ceilidhs. The Venue can also be set up in a 'big bar' style to accommodate larger socials.

Jim's Bar

Capacity:

- Standing - 150
- Seated - 80

Jim's Bar is a more intimate live music space with the original stage on which Queen performed. This is our 'mini Venue' which is ideal for smaller scale shows and club nights. This is your ideal space for pub quizzes and karaoke.

The Games Bar

Capacity:

- Standing - 150
- Seated - 80

Pool. Darts. Tv's and BT Sports. The Games bar is ready to host any social your mind can imagine, from your cosy karaoke to your post-game boozing sesh.

The Bistro

Capacity:

- Standing - 150
- Seated - 80

Our around the world street food dining restaurant is transformed in the evenings, to a social space like no other on campus. This lit-lanterned space is perfect for dinners and banquets.

Committee Rooms & Reflection Room

Capacity: 20-36

All of our committee rooms come equipped with a computer monitor and projector. These are your ideal spaced for meetings and AGMs. They can also be used for small socials such as movie screenings. Drinks purchased from the bar can be brought up to the committee rooms.

Foyer and Outside Area

In addition to our wide selection of rooms, all our affiliated clubs and societies can book the foyer and outside area for fundra stalls.

BOOKING FEES

Committee Rooms, The Foyer and The Bistro are free to book for any affiliated club or society.

Both Jim's Bar and the Games Bar are subject to a £150 booking fee. Fees are redeemable provided over £300.00 has been spent behind the bar.

The Venue is subject to a £400 room hire fee.
